

# BROWNTOP MILLET

**Scientific Name:** *Panicum Ramosum*

**Classification:** Warm seasonal annual

**Planting rate:** 10-15 pounds per acre

**Planting dates:** April 1-June 1

**Maturity:** 55-60 Days

**Seeds per pound:** 145,000

**Planting Depth:** 1 inch or less

**Drought Tolerance:** 1-10 scale (5)

***Browntop Millet*** is a warm season annual that grows 2-4 feet tall. A grassy looking millet that branches readily and resembles panicum grasses in its seed head. The seed is cream brown in color and in some cases will mature, drop, and some of the seeds will germinate to make another crop. Browntop is used for early season food for wildlife and as a food for ducks in ponds around the waters edge. Very drought tolerant
