

Japanese Millet

- Flooded Soils & Standing Water
- Weed Suppressing Cover Crop
- Waterfowl
- Tolerates Frequent Cutting
- Aggressive/Weedy
- Poor For Sandy Soils

Proso Millet

- Fast Growing
- Very Low Water Requirement
- Little Regrowth After Cutting

Pearl Millet

- Preferred Forage Millet
- Drought Resistant Grain
- Breaks Up Compaction
- Performs Well On Sandy Soils
- Can Accumulate High Levels of Nitrate

Browntop Millet

- Fast Growing
- Large Seed Producer For Wildlife
- Low Yield
- Can Accumulate Nitrate
- Weedy

- Can Only Be Cut Once
- May Accumulate Nitrate

Foxtail Millet

- Fast growing with high yields
- Weed Suppressing Cover Crop
- High salinity tolerance
- Good for Semi-Arid Regions
